Dear Parent/Guardian:

As you know the situation surrounding COVID-19 is evolving on a daily, and even hourly basis. This week alone, we've been in communication with the Department of Health, The New York State Education Department, the New York State Public High School Athletic Association and the Center for Disease Control.

It is important to note, while Bolton does not have a confirmed case of COVID-19, we are continuously making decisions with the safety of our students, staff and community in mind.

The Bolton Girls Varsity Basketball Regional Final has been postponed. No make-up date has been selected at this time. The New York State Youth & Government Conference in Albany has also been cancelled for this weekend (March 13 – March 15). Finally, the PTO March Madness Basketball Tournament scheduled for Saturday, March 21 has also been cancelled.

The BCS Drama Club Production is scheduled for Friday, March 27 and Saturday, March 28. A decision will be made on that in the near future.

Our schedule will continue to be modified as necessary and updates will be posted on our school district website.

The district continues to take normal flu season precautions to disinfect and sanitize the school building and are doing so at an increased frequency. School buses are getting cleaned and disinfected daily and teachers are taking additional steps in their classrooms as well (not sharing scissors and other supplies and eliminating group activities).

The Warren County Health Department will notify us if school closing becomes necessary due to COVID-19 circumstances.

I would like to reiterate, the health and safety of students, staff and our community is our number one priority and we will continue to implement any and all measures to that end.
